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Standard 4: Uniform Inspection Program

Purpose: to ensure uniformity among regulatory staff in interpretation of regulatory requirements, program policies and compliance/enforcement procedures

Goal: Uniform, high quality inspections – reducing risk factors associated with FBI

Requirements:

- On-going QA program
- Assure that each inspector complies with the 10 QA Program Elements
- Corrective action & 75%



Ten Quality Assurance Program Elements

- 1. Compliance status of each risk factor / intervention (IN, OUT, NA, NO)
- 2. Report is clear, legible, concise, and accurately reported
- 3. Interprets and applies laws, regulations, policies and procedures correctly
- 4. Cites the proper code provisions for risk factors and Code interventions
- Reviews past inspection findings acts on repeat or unresolved violations
- 6. Follows through with compliance and enforcement
- 7. Obtains and documents on-site corrective action as needed
- 8. Documents that options for long-term control of risk factors is discussed when repeat risk factors are observed
- 9. Verifies the establishment is assigned to proper risk category
- 10. Files reports / documentation in a timely manner



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
